



Usually at this time of year we would send home remembrance worship bags. Unfortunately due to current guidance this is not possible. However we will celebrate Remembrance in school and therefore would really appreciate the children's contributions to our school display: 'Wall of Remembrance'. Please could you follow the information on this sheet to remember a lost loved one and return the completed Poppy Template which the children should be bringing home this week.

During the month of November we especially remember those who have died – not just those who have died in wars but those too we have known and still love.

What to do:

Create a time of peace and calm.
Safely light a candle.
Make the sign of the cross
– in the name of the Father,
and of the Son
and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

Think about who you are offering your prayers up for and share this.



Say the prayer:
(You can insert the name/s of who you are praying for if you wish.)

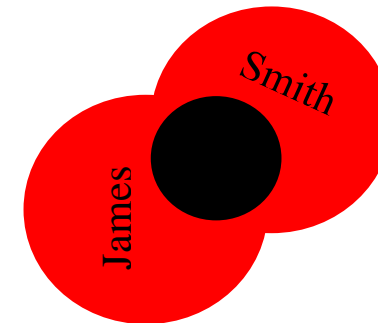
A special prayer to say for those who have died.
