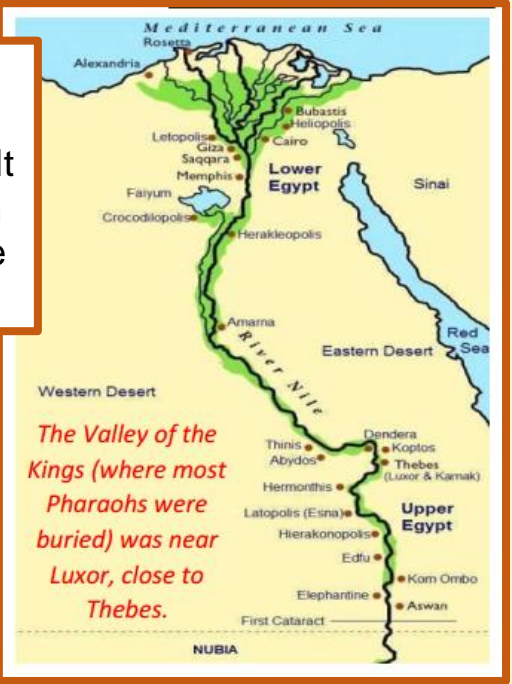


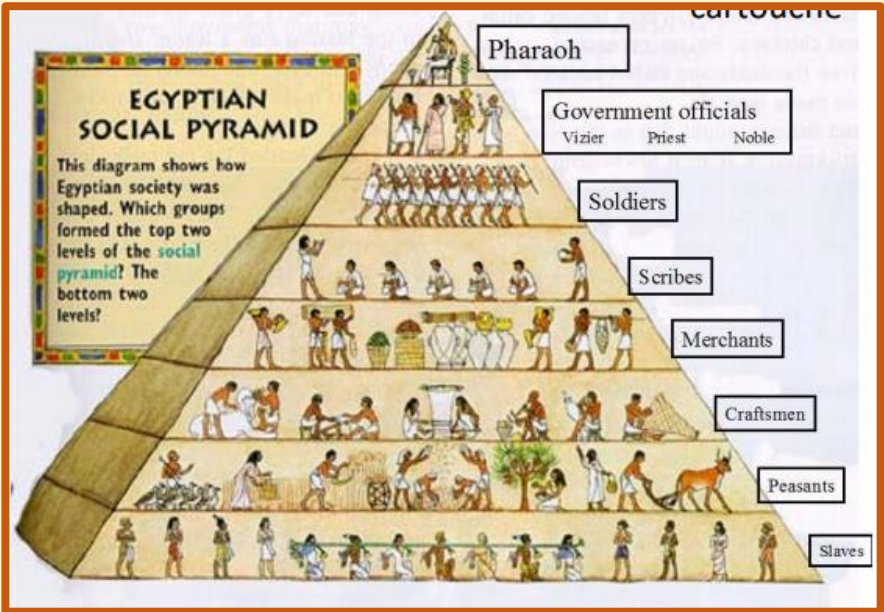
The River Nile flows right through Egypt from south to north. It is the longest river in the world and can be seen from space!



Key Vocabulary	
ancient	Belonging to the very distance past and no longer in existence.
civilisation	The society, culture and way of life of a particular area/ time period.
Pharaoh	Monarch or ruler of Ancient Egypt.
hieroglyphics	Pictures and symbols used as a form of early writing.
papyrus	A plant that grew on the banks of the River Nile which was used as early paper.
pyramid	A square-based structure often used as a tomb (a place to bury the dead). The three main types are the mastaba, the step pyramid and the true pyramid.
mummification	The process of preserving a body after death in preparation for the after life.
canopic jars	A container used to hold internal organs which were removed as part of the mummification process.
divine right	The belief that a monarch was given the right to rule by God/ gods.
hierarchy	How people are ranked according to their level of power and importance.
