This half term we are learning:

English

Jim and the Beanstalk- we will be writing our own version of Jim and the Beanstalk with a clear beginning, middle and end.

Maths

- Weight/mass and capacity/volume- measuring mass using non-standard units, comparing weight, solve problems involving weight and mass, measuring capacity using non-standard units, using 'full', 'nearly full', half full', 'nearly empty' and 'empty'.
- Multiplication and division- making equal groups, sharing into equal groups, making arrays.

RE - Resurrection

This half term we will be looking at the celebration of Easter. We will be talking about our thoughts and experiences of hope and joy. We will also be listening to Easter stories such as Doubting Thomas and Mary Magdala.

Science - Materials

In Science, we will be distinguishing objects and the materials that they are made from. We will be conducting experiments to test the different properties of materials.
